WOMT Radio is <u>YOUR</u> longstanding, #1 radio station in Manitowoc County.

WOMT has come a long way since its founder, Francis Kadow, first went on the air at 5:30 PM on November 8th, 1926. At that time, WOMT's studios and office were located at the second story of the Mikadow Theater Building across from Washington Park in Manitowoc.

Francis and Lillian Kadow owned and operated the station until 1967, when it was purchased by Wisconsin Fuel & Light Company and was moved to their building on North 10th Street.

Don Seehafer of Seehafer Broadcasting, purchased WOMT on January 1, 1970 and remained owner of the station until Mark Seehafer purchased the company on January 1, 2015.

WOMT's studios and offices are located on Mangin Street in Manitowoc and have been operating from that location since 1980.
